







ONE PAGE PROFILE

Create your own one page profile to introduce yourself to an older person living in a care home! One page profiles are a great way to get to know each other better and find common interests.

Equipment needed

- A4 paper or card either print our template one page profile, or copy the template and make your own version
- Pencils and pens
- Any other materials you'd like to use to decorate your profile

Method

- 1. Take a look at the template one page profile. (You can copy this template to make you own if you'd like). Draw a picture of yourself in the empty box top left, so that the older person knows what you look like. Be creative with materials! If you have a photograph of yourself, you could attach this instead.
- 2. Next think about your answers to all the questions. What would you like the older person to know about you?

 If you're not sure what to write for a section, you could always ask a sibling or an adult for some answers.

- 3. Finally, feel free to decorate your one page profile! You could use colour pens, or stickers, or any craft materials you have.
